

# **Extension - Non-Binding Solicitation of Interest**

# **Tri-State Energy Corridor**

Southern Star announced a Non-Binding Solicitation of Interest that started **Monday October 13, 2025 9:00am CCT and is now extended to Friday December 5, 2025 4:00pm CCT** for a possible pipeline expansion project designed to transport natural gas across the Northeast Oklahoma, Southeast Kansas, and Southwest Missouri corridor. This initiative aims to support high-growth economic development opportunities such as data centers, power generation facilities, and meet the rising energy demands of domestic industrial and manufacturing sectors.

This solicitation gives potential participants the opportunity to provide input on gas supply and routing options. As interest is identified, the path may change to optimize economics, and Southern Star will evaluate laterals based upon requests.
